

Washtenaw Health Plan Covered Services

Medically necessary services covered	Notes
Cancer Screenings	Cervical and breast cancer screenings, colonoscopy, FIT, labs, imaging, radiology, treatment. Not covered: Cologuard, genetic testing.
Contraception	Contraception methods and sterilization procedures for men and women are covered by WHP, MOMS Medicaid, and Patient Assistance Programs (PAPs). See webpage for details.
Diabetes Management	Free glucometer option available through Ascensia. Prescriptions, test strips, and lancets covered at local pharmacies. Shoe inserts available with a prescription from Michigan Medicine Orthotics and Prosthetics Center. MSupport helps cover the cost.
Durable Medical Equipment (DME)	Up to \$250/year at WHP-accepting DME providers. Use of community loan closets encouraged for other needs.
Emergency and Outpatient Hospital Care	Medically necessary services received at Michigan Medicine, Trinity Health/IHA/St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, and Chelsea Hospital (Washtenaw County locations only). Ambulance covered by Medicaid-ESO within last 90 days. Charity care also available.
Immunizations	Excludes travel immunizations. Covered at primary care offices (children only at Packard Health); Washtenaw County Health Department Clinic (sliding-scale fees available); and flu, COVID-19, pneumonia, and shingles vaccines at most local pharmacies.
Inpatient Hospital Care	Excludes inpatient psychiatric care, which is referred to Community Mental Health (CMH). Michigan Medicine, Trinity Health/IHA/St. Joseph Mercy Hospital. Washtenaw County locations only.
Mental Health Care	Up to 52 visits/year with WHP-accepting therapists. Please see webpage for providers that accept WHP. Substance use and inpatient psychiatric treatment referred to Community Mental Health (CMH).
Physical Therapy	Limited number of sessions covered at Washtenaw County Probility locations.
Prescriptions	Copays: \$5 (generic) \$7 (brand name) at most local pharmacies. See webpage for details.
Primary Care	Michigan Medicine, Trinity Health/IHA, Packard Health, The Corner Health Center. Washtenaw County locations only.
Radiology, Imaging, and Labs	Michigan Medicine, Trinity Health/IHA/St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Chelsea Hospital. Washtenaw County locations only.
Specialty Care	Michigan Medicine, Trinity Health/IHA/St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, and many Trinity Health-affiliated independent specialists. See webpage for independent specialists that accept WHP. Washtenaw County locations only.
Urgent Care	Only at IHA/Trinity Health Washtenaw County locations.
