Programs that help with Medicare costs include:

AD Care Medicaid (Aged and Disabled)

Adds dental and vision coverage for people who are enrolled in Medicare, and covers co-pays, deductibles, and premiums.

The Medicare Savings Program

Pays the Part B premium. If your income and assets are very low the program will also cover deductibles, co-insurance, co-pays and additional services.

Extra Help

Helps pay for Medicare drug coverage (Part D) premiums, deductibles, coinsurance, and other costs.
